

## SEMINAR ON COURSE SYLLABUS

(20.09.2021–24.09.2021) 11:00 AM–12:00 PM For V Semester Students Department of English Govt. Johnson College

Student–Teacher Programme is meant to give students practice speaking in front of a live audience (via googlemeet) and to explore topics in detail. The seminar is intended to improve students respond to critical feedback, including improving communication skills, gaining expert knowledge, networking with others and renewing motivation and confidence. Students will research topics and organize presentations (for faculty and fellow students). The topics may be any aspect of the Course Syllabus and students may not give a presentation similar to one the other students have delivered/Presented i.e. your topic should be substantially different from your classmates.

## Guidelines for the Seminar:

- The said seminar will be held every day between 11AM– 12PM from 20<sup>th</sup> September to 24<sup>th</sup> September 2021 (Monday– Friday)
- Students will be divided into five groups. One group for each day of the seminar
- Each student will give 15-minutes presentation on any aspect of the Course Syllabus
- Mark Scheme for Presentation:
  - $\checkmark$  Completion of presentation (by each group) = 4 marks
  - ✓ Content of the Presentation = 6 marks
  - ✓ Student's Performance (in the Presentation) = 6 marks Total 4 + 6 + 6 = 16 marks
- Each student will receive feedback from the professors after delivering the presentation
- Attendance at each seminar is mandatory for all students. Failure to participate in the seminar will also be taken into account in final grading.
- The effort by students to meet these expectations will be considered in the determination of your internal marks.
